POSITION DESCRIPTION

Field Maintenance Technician

Reports to: Field Maintenance Supervisor

Basic Function: The Field Maintenance Technician is responsible for maintaining the airfield and

approaches to the airfield, including pavements, grounds, structures, and airfield

equipment. Perform construction activities as assigned.

Physical Requirements:

The tasks assigned to the Field Maintenance Technician require that the employee maintain high levels of energy with the capability of lifting heavy objects.

Duties and Responsibilities:

Under the general supervision of the Field Maintenance Supervisor, Field Maintenance Technicians have the following responsibilities:

■ Mow the airfield and grounds.

■ Remove snow from airfield pavements.

■ Spread sand or apply chemicals for snow and ice control.

■ Maintain airfield lighting system.

■ Repair pavements on the airfield and supporting roads.

■ Maintain and install fencing.

■ Maintain drainage systems.

Clear brush and weeds.

■ Maintain structures.

■ Assist in maintaining equipment.

 Ability to pass a background check, a pre-employment physical exam, and drug screen

■ Perform other tasks as assigned related to operating and maintaining the airfield.

Skill Qualifications:

The Field Crew should possess the following skills and abilities:

- Ability to operate and use efficiently all airport vehicles and equipment on the field and on highways.
- General knowledge of carpentry, electrical, plumbing, drainage, pavement and grounds maintenance skills.
- Ability to operate communications equipment.
- Ability to learn.
